Many look-a-like grips are showing up on e-bay and in a few dealer locations at reduced prices.

Things you should know about the grip marketplace:

Hoodman rejected its first supply of PowerGrips because they did not function as promised. The Hoodman engineering team solved the grip problems and flew to China to outline strict Hoodman electrical specs for all Hoodman PowerGrips. All Hoodman PowerGrips are built to superior specs with regard to the wiring and fiber optic cable components.

The rest of the look-a-like grips in the USA selling at reduced prices will not function as promised. When you place one EN-EL3 battery in the grip and the battery is at less than full power, your camera will shut down with a low power indicator. The AA battery cartridge will not function more than one time before shutting the camera down with a low power indicator. The fiber optic cable does not tuck in neatly along the body of the camera and the adhesive holding the mounting pad to the camera will fail.

Please be aware that the look-a-like grips that you can buy for less, will not perform as promised.
